REGISTRATION FEES AND REFUND POLICY

Initial _____

The registration fee for participation in LWYFL is \$125 per participant. Families with more than one participant pay as follows: the 1st child pays \$125, the 2nd child pays \$93.75 and each additional child pays \$62.50. REGISTRATION FEES ARE NON-REFUNDABLE.

ASSIGNMENT OF PARTICIPANTS TO TEAMS

Initial _____

The Board of Directors supervise the player draft. Teams are divided into multiple colors including Maroon, White, Black or Silver. All siblings are assigned to the same color/team unless otherwise requested or team color is not available. Requests to play a specific team or to be on a team with a friend are not permitted. Head Coaches draft their teams. If you do not wish to be protected, discuss it with the head coach.

WOJFC REQUIREMENTS

Initial _____

The LWYFL is part of the Western Ohio Junior Football Conference (WOJFC).

The WOJFC requires all LWYFL football participants to have a physical check up. Physicals must be in the 2010 calendar year. Physicals dated prior to 1/1/2010 will NOT be accepted by the WOJFC. ****ONLY THE WOJFC 3 PART PHYSICAL FORM WILL BE ACCEPTED.****

The WOJFC required admission fee for all games, both home and away, is \$2 per person over 6 years old including coaching staff and team moms. Only football players and cheerleaders are exempt.

VOLUNTEERISM

Initial _____

The LWYFL is a volunteer organization. NEW IN 2010** The LWYFL has adopted a One and Done Volunteer Program. Each participant must have 1 grownup contribute 1 volunteer shift per season. This includes all coaching staff, board members and team moms. A volunteer shift takes place at our home field during a game that your child does NOT play. You will not miss any playing time for your child. Additional information will be given at the Parent Meeting May 16, 2010 4-6pm.

EQUIPMENT POLICY

Initial _____

I acknowledge that I am responsible for returning all LWYFL issued equipment/uniform at the end of the season in acceptable condition. I agree to pay the replacement cost for any equipment issued to my child lost or damaged beyond normal wear. If the borrowed equipment is not returned, my child will not be permitted to register for the next season until the equipment has been returned.

PARENTS CODE OF ETHICS

Initial _____

I hereby pledge to provide positive support, care and encouragement for my child participating in youth sports by following this Parents' Code of Ethics:

I will encourage good sportsmanship by demonstrating positive support for all players, coaches, and officials at all LWYFL and WOJFC practices, games, functions and youth sports events.

I will place the emotional and physical well being of my child ahead of my personal desire to win.

I will insist my child play in a safe and healthy environment.

I will require that my child's coach be trained in the responsibilities of being a youth sports coach and that the coach uphold the Coaches' Code of Ethics.

I will support coaches and officials working with my child, in order to encourage a positive and enjoyable experience for all.

I will demand a sports environment for my child that is free from drugs, alcohol, tobacco, and profanity and I will refrain from their use at all LWYFL and WOJFC practices, games, functions and youth sports events.

I will remember that the game is for youth and not adults.

I will do very best to make youth sports fun for my child and all of the children of the LWYFL and WOJFC.

I will ask my child to treat other players, coaches, fans, and officials with respect regardless of race, sex, creed or ability.

I will help my child enjoy the youth sports experience by conducting myself in a positive manner that sets a good example for the children at all LWYFL and WOJFC practices, games, functions and youth sporting events, by doing whatever I can such as being a respectful fan, and providing assistance where needed.
